MSU SYSTEMS & ACCOUNTS

Getting started with your new graduate program will involve several steps, and we want that process to go as smoothly as possible. This Next Steps guide for MAFLT and Certificate students will help you to create accounts, locate important sites, and take steps that need to happen before you can participate in courses and engage with the MAFLT Network. The MSU Graduate School also provides you with a Welcome Letter and Welcome Packet. They are full of instructions and resources for all new students. LOG IN | <u>NETID.MSU.EDU/STUDENT</u>

Begin by setting up your MSU ID. Read instructions for Getting Started here: <u>https://netid.msu.edu/student</u>.

- Getting up multi-factor authentication: https://secureit.msu.edu/multi-factor.

You will use your MSU ID (your email address) and password to log in to most MSU platforms. Using your MSU email address to set up accounts on other sites can create a security risk, so avoid doing that unless instructed.

ACTIVATE EMAIL | <u>SPARTANMAIL.MSU.EDU</u>

Set up your MSU email account at <u>https://spartanmail.msu.edu</u>. We use MSU email, not personal email, to communicate with our students. You can open it in a browser or use the Outlook app on your computer and mobile devices. Get help here: <u>https://tech.msu.edu/students/</u>.

ONLINE LEARNING SYSTEM | <u>D2L.MSU.EDU</u>

□ Log in to D₂L at: <u>https://d2l.msu.edu</u>. Look for the tile for the MAFLT Community on your D₂L Home screen. If you don't see it, let us know so that we can add you manually right away.

All of our courses are delivered via MSU's learning management system, D2L. Throughout your time in the program, you will have access to a D2L site called the MAFLT Community. You may not see other courses yet. Your instructors will notify you when course sites open, and you can adjust other notifications in your D2L Profile.

STUDENT INFO SYSTEM | <u>STUDENT.MSU.EDU</u>

- For most of the steps you need to take as a student at MSU, start with the Student Information System (SIS).
 Log in to the Student Information System (SIS) at: <u>student.msu.edu</u>. This site uses the same password and two-factor authentication as D₂L, the MSU Library, and most other MSU sites.
- MSU provides a guide for students here: <u>sis.msu.edu/learn-more</u>. This portal serves as a starting place for most steps you need to take to monitor your progress, accounts, calendar, etc. at MSU.

ENROLLMENT | <u>STUDENT.MSU.EDU</u>

- □ You can enroll in your courses now. Log in to SIS (see above) and click Class Search. MSU provides detailed instructions for Class Search and Enrollment here: <u>sis.msu.edu/help/enrollment</u>.

FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS | SIS.MSU.EDU

- From there, you can go to Class Search, Billing, and Academic Records, etc. You will see Advising, but do not make advising appointments here. Your advisor is the <u>FLT Program Director</u>.

 Your account is managed by the Office of the Controller: <u>ctlr.msu.edu/COStudentAccounts</u>.
- Notifications about billing and payments will come through email and your MSU student account. If you get a message you do not understand, let us know, but you will also need to contact the Controller's Office directly.

SPARTAN365 | <u>SPARTAN365.MSU.EDU</u>

- The Spartan365 page (https://spartan365.msu.edu) gives you access to all of our Microsoft Office 365 apps.
 They are all provided with your MSU account no extra charge. Click Install Now to download Word, Excel,
 Outlook, PowerPoint, etc. You will need to submit assignments in these formats, not Apple or Google formats.
- Download Microsoft Teams from Spartan₃₆₅ also. This is the main way that we communicate, along with D₂L. You can get to it online at <u>teams.Microsoft.com/go#</u>. You can also download Teams to your computer and/or go to your mobile device's App Store to get the Teams app, along with other Spartan₃₆₅ (Microsoft) apps.


